Psychiatrist or Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner Job Announcement

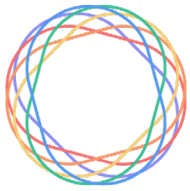
Seattle Counseling Service (www.seattlecounseling.org) is a community resource that advocates, educates and serves to advance the social well-being and mental health of the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Queer (LGBTQ) community.

Seattle Counseling Service (SCS) is looking for a Physician or Nurse Practitioner to work alongside a dedicated and collaborative psychiatric medical team, to ensure that SCS clients receive clinically excellent, trauma-informed, and timely psychiatric evaluations, diagnosis, and treatment.

Responsibilities:

- Provide comprehensive psychiatric care both in-person and via HIPAA-compliant telemedicine platform, specifically:
 - Conduct psychiatric evaluations for current SCS clients, and provide recommendations for treatment.
 - Provide ongoing psychiatric medication management, carrying an individual caseload of psychiatric clients, in consultation with therapists, case managers, and nursing support.
 - Order and document medically necessary diagnostic tests and procedures.
 - Advocate through best clinical practice, for the rights of all individuals who seek care at SCS, including writing endorsements for gender affirming care, housing support, and environmental accommodations whenever clinically appropriate.
 - Notify appropriate personnel of routine and emergent client information.
 - Document all client contacts and pertinent information in the electronic health record.

- Participate in the development, approval, and review of all policies, procedures, and protocols that govern clinical care.
- Participate in ongoing clinical consultation with staff and trainees, individually, as appropriate, and in team meetings.
- Seek coordination/referral and direct service, in-house and out of facility, as appropriate to client's care.
- Seek clinical consultation and mentorship as needed to ensure quality of care.
- Maintain required caseload and direct service productivity as assigned by the medical director.



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Qualifications:

- Psychiatrist or PMHNP, licensed in Washington State by the date of hire.
- At least 1 year of post-graduate experience prescribing psychiatric care in an outpatient setting
- Demonstrated knowledge of and respect for the unique health and cultural needs of the LGBTQIA+ community.
- Willingness to provide quality clinical supervision to clinicians and trainees within a team environment
- Demonstrated experience within a community mental health setting.
- Clozapine REMS certified within 3 months of hire.
- Active buprenorphine waiver, or ability to complete waiver within 3 months of hire
- Ability to complete assigned tasks, accept responsibility and meet all WAC and funding requirements for appropriate client supervision and treatment.
- Bi-lingual language skills highly desired

Schedule: Part time: 0.5FTE, hours as arranged with Medical Director. No afterhours or weekends.

Salary: \$1,248.00 - \$2,831.00 per week; Depends on experience and/or presence of a doctorate degree.

Benefits: Generous sick leave, vacation leave, paid holidays, medical, dental and vision plans, 401K with 3% employer match.
